It's against the law to physically handle a wireless telecommunications device while operating a vehicle.

## **THIS INCLUDES:**

- Using a wireless telecommunications device to write, send or engage via text
- Watching, recording or capturing photo/video
- Engaging in voice-based communication
- Physically holding or supporting device with any part of body

A wireless telecommunications device includes but is not limited to:

- Smartphones
- Cell phones
- Electronic readers or tablets
- Laptops or netbooks
- GPS devices

## **GET READY**

After July 1, 2024, motorists who violate the hands-free ordinance may receive a citation and be ordered to pay the following fines:

- \$50 for a first conviction
- \$100 for a second conviction
- \$150 for a third conviction and/or community service
